Notes to statistical tables

1. Excluded records

Since 2012-13 students have the option of recording gender as 'Other'. Fewer than five students fall within this category and data for these students are excluded from all tables to ensure that individuals cannot be identified (owing to the small number in this category and the detailed presentation of data).

2. General notes

2.1. The census date for this publication is 31 July of each academic year and the tables do not reflect any amendments to the results made at a later date. Thus, the results of the candidates who, on 31 July, were not classed and were still awaiting a decision from the Applications Committee are not included in any of the tables. If a candidate successfully re-sat all the failed components of their examination by 31 July, their results are included in the relevant class category; otherwise their results are included in the 'Other results' category (see note 2.3 below).

2.2. All of the tables exclude:

- a. Candidates for all postgraduate-level examinations. The exceptions are integrated masters programmes in: Chemical Engineering (Part IIB: Chemical Engineering Tripos); Engineering (Part IIB: Engineering Tripos); Manufacturing Engineering (Part II: Manufacturing Engineering); Mathematics (Part III: Mathematical Tripos); Natural Sciences (Part III: Biochemistry, Part III: Chemistry, Part III: Experimental and Theoretical Physics, Part III: Geological Sciences, Part III: History and Philosophy of Science, Part III: Materials Science, and Part III: Systems Biology).
- b. Candidates for all undergraduate-level diploma and certificate examinations.
- c. Candidates who took examinations as candidates 'not for honours' or candidates who were not aiming for a qualification, e.g. all incoming exchange and other visiting students and Cambridge graduates reading Triposes.
- d. Candidates for oral examinations in Modern and Medieval Languages and Asian and Middle Eastern Studies.
- e. Candidates for the examination in Law for European Students.

2.3. The heading 'Other results' in all tables includes but does not differentiate between:

- a. Candidates who failed their examinations.
- b. Candidates who have received allowances (deemed to have deserved honours (DDH) or were granted an allowance towards the Ordinary degree) or have been permitted to take a reduced number of examinations by the Applications Committee of the Council. Allowances may be granted to

candidates who have been ill or who have other extenuating circumstances and have thus been prevented from taking an examination or whose performance has been adversely affected as a consequence.

- c. Candidates for examinations in Part II and Part III of the Final M.B. and Part III of the Final Vet.M.B. who failed any part of these examinations.

2.4. The class obtained in each language by candidates for Part IA of the Modern and Medieval Languages Tripos has been counted as half a class. This explains why in some tables the numbers of candidates under each class division for this Tripos and in the totals are not whole units.

3. Time series tables

3.1. In order to maintain continuity, from 2011 the Honours examinations results are presented in two ways. Table TS_01a corresponds to the Table 1a from the Examination Statistics publications before 2011 and includes unclassified Tripos results. In this table Part III of the Mathematical Tripos, Part IIB of the Manufacturing Engineering Tripos and Part IIB of the Engineering Tripos are re-coded into classes as follows:

- a. In Part III of the Mathematical Tripos, a pass with distinction or merit has been recoded as Class I, and a pass as Class II division (1).
- b. In Part IIB of the Engineering and Manufacturing Engineering Triposes, a pass with distinction has been re-coded as Class I, a pass with merit as Class II division (1), and a pass as Class II division (2).

In 2011-2012 a new unclassified Tripos part – Part III of the Computer Science Tripos – was introduced. This Tripos part is excluded from Table TS_01a.

3.2. From 2010-11, a new table – Table TS_01b – was introduced. This table excludes the results of all unclassified Tripos examinations so that the total in this table is consistent with that of Table UNI_01, 'Classified Tripos examination results'.

3.3. Up to and including 2009-10, the Certificate in Advanced Study in Mathematics (Part III of the Mathematical Tripos) was open to both students continuing on from Mathematics Part II as the fourth year of their course, as well as to direct entrants. In 2010-11 this qualification was replaced by two new qualifications: students who continue to Part III of the Mathematical Tripos as part of an integrated masters programme aim for a Master of Mathematics; whereas direct entrants aim for the postgraduate qualification, Master of Advanced Study. As a result, from 2011 there are fewer candidates for Part III of the Mathematical Tripos.

4. University and college tables

4.1 Most of the Preliminary and Tripos examinations are classified, i.e. the names of successful candidates are arranged in three classes, of which the second class can be divided into two divisions or can remain undivided. However, some Preliminary and Tripos examinations are unclassified, i.e. the names of successful candidates are arranged in one class and it is noted if a candidate has passed with distinction or merit. The results for classified and unclassified Preliminary and Tripos examinations

are presented in separate tables. Please see Appendix 1 for a full list of examinations and their type.

4.2. Pre-clinical medical and veterinary students read the Medical and Veterinary Sciences Tripos in years one and two, but read a different Tripos in year three. In the third year they are included under the Tripos examination for which they were entered.

4.3. Postgraduate-level examination results are excluded from this publication. As a result of this, two graduate-only colleges – Clare Hall and Darwin College – do not appear in the tables.

5. Bio-demographic tables

5.1. Ethnicity and disability data are as reported on the basis of the student's self-assessment.

5.2. The order of ethnicity and disability categories is determined by numeric codes used in the annual return of student data to the Higher Education Statistics Agency (HESA).

6 Degrees tables

Table DG_01 provides the number of degrees conferred. It does not include information about qualifications that are awarded rather than conferred, for example the Postgraduate Certificate in Education (P.G.C.E.).

Table DG_02 provides the number of degrees completed. Completion of the degree indicates that the candidate successfully fulfilled all academic requirements for their degree and can therefore proceed to having the degree conferred or awarded. It does not mean that the candidate has necessarily had the degree conferred or awarded – thus there is a discrepancy between the numbers given in Tables DG_01 and DG_02.

Notes:

Candidates who were taking examinations, but not aiming for a qualification and candidates receiving allowances from the Applications Committee of the Council of the Senate were excluded from the 1972 statistics (and thereafter) although they had been included in previous years. Candidates receiving allowances from the Applications Committee have been reintroduced to the table from 2008.

Candidates for the LL.B. were included from 1972. Candidates for the LL.M., which replaced the LL.B. in 1982, were excluded from 1999.

Candidates for the B.Ed. degree were excluded from the statistics for the years 1972-79 inclusive, but following the introduction of the Education Tripos were included from 1980. (Note that, over time, the Tripos leading to the B.Ed. was replaced by Triposes leading to the B.A. degree.)

Candidates who were 'Deemed to have obtained Honours' while studying abroad are excluded from this table.

The results of some of the unclassified Triposes are re-coded for the purposes of this table. Please see note 3.1 on page 2 for details of which unclassified Triposes have been re-coded and included.

The class obtained in each language by candidates for Part IA of the Modern and Medieval Languages Tripos has been counted as half a class, thus the numbers of candidates in some cases are not whole units.

From 2011 candidates for unclassified Triposes are excluded from this table. In previous years the results of those examinations were re-coded to fit the classified examinations format (see note 3.1 on page 2 for details). This explains the change in number and percentage of Class I results for Engineering, Manufacturing Engineering and Mathematics subjects between 2010 and 2011.

Triposes in the state of transition (Oriental Studies to Asian & Middle Eastern Studies and Social and Political Sciences to Politics, Psychology & Sociology) are presented separately.

For all years this table excludes candidates for unclassified Preliminary and other examinations, candidates for Final M.B. and Vet.M.B. examinations and candidates 'Deemed to have obtained Honours' while studying abroad.

The class obtained in each language by candidates for Part IA of the Modern and Medieval Languages Tripos has been counted as half a class, thus the numbers of candidates in some class categories for this subject area and in the totals are not whole units.

From 2014 the First Examination for the Bachelor of Theology for Ministry Degree was classified for the first time, whereas prior to 2014 only the Second Examination was classified. Hence there is an increase in the number of candidates within the subject, 'Theology for Ministry' in 2014.
